- 29% Local Revenues
 - Total Revenues at 46.3%
- Expenditures
 - Salaries and wages are right around 50%
 - Most the High percentages are things we need at beginning of year
 - o 42% expenses
- Food Services are right around 45%
- Total Revenues All funds 45.1%
- Total Expenditures All funds 41.2%
