## **HOW TO INTERPRET YOUR RESULT**

Your result of **2.0 ppb** is below the below the Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) action level of 15.0 ppb. One ppb is equivalent to about three seconds in 100 years. However, according to the EPA, there is no level of lead that is without risk.

## THINGS YOU CAN DO TO HELP PROTECT YOUR WATER FROM LEAD

## THINGS THE CITY DOES TO HELP PROTECT YOUR WATER FROM LEAD

Lead can leach into the water when it comes in direct contact with lead and galvanized steel water service lines and household plumbing fixtures. The way we treat Minneapolis water before it makes it to your home helps to keep the lead in piping systems from dissolving into your drinking water.
